

Church in Los Angeles – 2009 Summer School of Truth

May 25, 2009

To all the saints in Los Angeles, Thousand Oaks, Santa Clarita and Glendale:

The Summer School of Truth this year will be from July 13th to July 26th 2009 at 8655 Haskell Ave, Los Angeles, California. We invite those going into 7th grade through 12th grade to attend this time as well as any saints who would like to serve for the care of those in this age group. **Registration is due Lord's Day, June 21st, 2009** and we ask that young people and serving ones sign up at <http://www.losangelesyp.org> as well as turn in the registration form below to the Hall 2 service office.

This year we will have the meetings during the week in the evenings, starting from dinner at 5:30 PM and the meeting starting at 6:30 PM. As always, we are burdened to help all the saints into an experiential realization of the truth, not merely a doctrinal understanding. It is not a small thing to learn to pay the price in this age to gain the oil in your vessels for the next age (Matt. 25). Please pray that every young person would have a personal touch with the Lord in a way that would affect the rest of their lives.

The nourishing truth which we will cover will be from Lesson Book, Level 2 entitled "The Triune God and the Person and Work of Christ".

We encourage all the graduating seniors, college students, young adults, middle age and above to come and function as serving ones. Serving ones will be ask to attend several fellowship times so that we can pray for the young people and coordinate for the small groups. You can register one of two ways:

1. **You can register on line** by going to <http://losangelesyp.org/> and fill out the form of when you can come and check all appropriate boxes. Check the boxes of the meetings that you are committed to going. You can always come to more than you committed to. Bring check for \$50 to the service office by June 21 and your committed SSOT registration form signed by you and your parent. For all those under 18, if you did not attend a YP's conference this year we will need you to fill out a medical release form as well, to bring to the service office by June 21.
2. **You can register at the service office.** The SSOT registration form can be obtained at the Hall 2 service office and signed by both parent and child (if under 18) along with a non-refundable registration fee of **\$50.00** must be turned in by June 21 to the service office for those who meet at Hall 2. For all those under 18, if you did not attend a YP's conference this year we will need you to fill out a medical release form as well.

Other districts need to make their own arrangements to submit registrations to Hall 2 by June 21. Regarding the summer school, we have enclosed: (1) a copy of the summer school regulations, (2) a schedule showing meeting times and locations, and (3) a registration form. Please take the time to look at them with your son or daughter and sign form.

These times together are always a profit to the young people, all those who serve, and the entire church. Please pray that the Lord will again afford His blessing during this time and grant us the spirit of the gospel.

2009 SUMMER SCHOOL OF TRUTH

Regulations

Certain regulations are necessary to maintain a proper atmosphere and to gain the maximum benefit from the time we spend together. They are listed here:

1. Anyone who wishes to attend will be required to register. Signed **registration forms, by you and your parent** must be turned in by Lord's Day, June 21 with payment of \$50.
2. Anyone who wishes to bring an unregistered guest to one of the meetings should secure permission from a serving one *before* that meeting.
3. Everyone should attend all meetings for which they are registered. Attendance will be taken at each meeting.
4. Everyone will be expected to be in his or her seat five minutes *before* the scheduled start of each meeting.
5. Extra assignments (verse memorization, written questions etc.) will be given.
6. All attending are expected to function in the way of exercising their spirit to sing, pray, and share in the meetings.
7. We ask that during all meetings that all electronics be turned off to give the Spirit our utmost cooperation so that He could speak to us.
8. We ask that during the summer school of truth, all speaking would be for building up.
9. The following **dress code** will be in effect. All attire will be subject to the approval of a serving one. Young people not in adherence may be sent home to change.

Brothers

- a. Collared shirts(not tight fitting)
- b. Past SSOT-shirts
- c. No shirts with logos or inappropriate symbols
- d. Long pants (No short, baggy, tight fitting, or athletic outfits).
- e. Shoes (no flip-flops)
- f. Socks must be worn.

Sisters

- a. Modest shirts with a proper neckline and sleeves (no tight or sleeveless)
- b. Past SSOT-shirts
- c. No shirts with logos or inappropriate symbols
- d. Knee-length or longer skirts or dresses
- e. Long pants (No shorts, nor tight fitting pants, nor athletic outfits)
- f. Shoes (no flip-flops)
- g. Socks must be worn
